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GENERAL GUIDELINES

- 1 The JUDGING PANEL shall comprise no less than three persons assembled annually by the Chairperson of Buller Electricity Limited in consultation with local BEL Directors.
- 2 There shall be EITHER ONE PANEL to cover all Awards OR A SEPARATE JUDGING PANEL for each of the classes of Awards.
- 3 The decisions of the Selection Panel(s) shall be FINAL AND BINDING.
- 4 To ensure that there shall be MAXIMUM coverage of the acknowledgement of service and achievement, whilst still limiting the Awards to the numbers stipulated, NO SINGLE PERSON shall receive MORE THAN ONE AWARD in any one year.
- 5 A person receiving a Rangatahi Leadership Award may **not** be nominated for a Rangatahi Leadership Award and considered for selection in the following or any subsequent year.
- 6 UNSUCCESSFUL NOMINEES may be renominated in the year following or any subsequent years.

Rangatahi Leadership

The Kawatiri Rangatahi Leadership Award is designed to recognise and celebrate the passion, success and commitment of any rangatahi (aged between 12 to 24 years) living in the Kawatiri region who is striving to improve themselves and our community (hapori).

The judges will consider the following when considering the nomination:

- Their contribution to advancing community aspirations
- Demonstration of the core values of kotahitanga, rangatiratanga, whanaungatanga and manaakitanga
 - Kotahitanga: working actively to protect the people, the environment, knowledge, culture and resources important to our Kawatiri community
 - Rangatiratanga: striving to maintain a high degree of personal integrity and ethical behaviour in all our actions and decisions
 - Whanaungatanga: respecting, fostering and maintaining important relationships within the community
 - Manaakitanga: paying respect to and looking after all people in the community
- Initiatives demonstrated in a leadership capacity
- The involvement in establishing and/or setting the direction of a group, organisation, or cause in which they have been involved
- Guidance, support, training and encouragement of group members
- Effort in working toward goals
- Commitment to own personal development by participation in courses, forums, conventions, community activities and other training or educational opportunities
